Academic Advising Notes: ^S Effective Fall 2012, all incoming Schreyer Honors College freshmen at University Park will take [ENGL/CAS 137H](#) in the fall semester and [ENGL/CAS 138T](#) in the spring semester. These courses carry GWS designation and replace both ENGL 030 and CAS 100. Each course is 3 credits. At the discretion of the college, ENGL/CAS 138T satisfies the first-year seminar requirement.

Program Notes:

¹ Students are encouraged to take HD FS 312W during the second year, if possible.

² Enroll in HD FS 401 only if HD FS 402 and HD FS 495C will be taken.

³ Enroll in HD FS 490 only if HD FS 495A and 495B will be taken.

It is recommended that General Education Arts (GA) and Humanities (GH) courses be taken in junior and senior year if student plans to study abroad. International Cultures (IL) may be combined with GA, GH, or GS. HD FS US Cultures requirement suggested in Semester 7 is in addition to the university requirement. HD FS 315 satisfies the university requirement for US.
