

Tentative Itinerary:

The following is a proposed itinerary and should be considered a preliminary draft. Its final implementation will depend on factors such as organizational availability. Nonetheless, the final program will maintain the same level of quality and intensity as outlined here.

Sunday, May 10:

- Arrival and hotel check-in
- Guided walking tour of Amsterdam
- Welcome dinner

Monday, May 11 (Zwolle):

- Travel by bus to Zwolle
- Welcome session 'How to survive the Netherlands' by Edutravel
- Introductory lecture by Christina Daley at Windesheim University of Applied Sciences
- Lunch at Windesheim University of Applied Sciences (possibly together with Dutch students)
- Introductory lecture by Simone de Bruin at Windesheim University of Applied Sciences
- Presentation on Euthanasia at Windesheim University of Applied Sciences

Tuesday, May 12 (Amsterdam):

- Morning: Presentation on Buurtzorg, a Dutch healthcare organization that provides community-based nursing care through small, self-managed teams that support clients in their homes.
